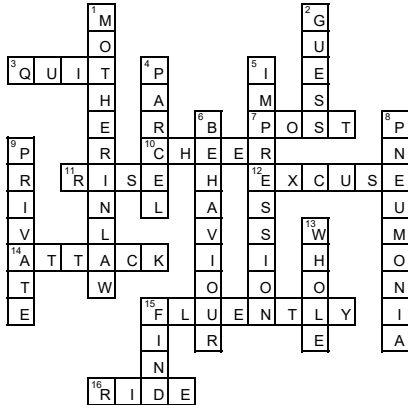

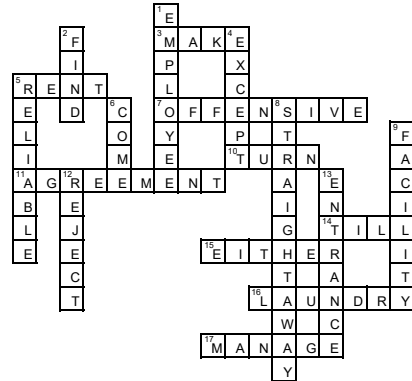
Krzyżówka ze słówkami z rozdziałów **23, 24 i 25**.



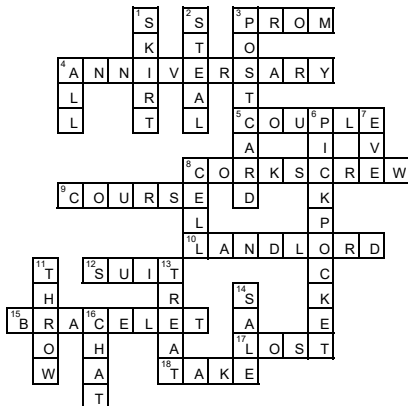
Krzyżówka ze słówkami z rozdziałów **26 i 27**.
